a week? (Including doses used for exercise)		
2. Do you cough, wheeze, or have a tight chest because of your asthma? (4 or more times a week)		
3. Does a cough, wheezing or chest tightness wake you at night? (1 or more times a week)		
4. Do you stop exercising because of your asthma? (In the past 3 months)		
5. Do you ever miss work, school or social activities because of your asthma? (In the past 3 months)		

Even one "YES" means that you should talk to a doctor and ask about a referral to the Asthma Education Clinic.
