IMPROVEMENTS UNDERWAY

• In collaboration with internal and external partners (ie: Social Development, Extra-Mural Program, etc.), we are developing a process to better identify, assess and coordinate care for vulnerable patients with complex needs. The target population of the pilot phase of the project are those clients who are identified as "familiar faces" in the Emergency Department.

ACHIEVEMENTS

- Needle disposal boxes were installed in various locations to improve public safety by facilitating proper needle disposal in the community
- Primary Health Care Access Coordinator has connected over 400 clients who were previously without access, to a primary care provider.
