They were approved by the Provincial COVID-19 Task Force. The program will be launched beginning March 25<sup>th</sup>.</li> <li>In Horizon, the DSP program will be rolled out in phases to ensure the communication and education materials are appropriate. This roll out will start with two Alternative Level of Care Patient Care Units at The Moncton Hospital and Ridgewood Veteran's Wing in Saint John. Phase 2 will include all Alternate Level of Care Units and the Veteran's Health Unit. Phase 3 will be all other patient care units.</li> <li>Co-Chair W.
