### **Who you are**

You are practicing physician in the applicable zone, who is a member in good standing of the Active Medical Staff of the Regional Health Authority and who carries on an active medical practice. In addition, the Local Chief of Staff should be an experienced physician respected by colleagues.

### **Key Responsibilities:**

The Local Chief of Staff is responsible for the following:

- i. Overseeing the quality of medical care in all facilities in their zone;
- ii. Implementing policies established by the RMAC regarding monitoring and improving patient care;
- iii. Participating in planning activities related to the provision of medical care in facilities;
- iv. Chairing the LMAC;
- v. Assisting in the management of physician complaints and the dispute resolution process;
- vi. Working with department heads to identify areas of risk for patients;
- vii. Encouraging and promoting a culture of quality and patient safety;
- viii. Orchestrating change where necessary; and
- ix. Such other duties and responsibilities as may be assigned to them from time to time by the Regional Chief of Staff.

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### Terms of Appointments

The Local Chief of Staff shall be appointed for a three (3) year term and shall be eligible for reappointment for one (1) additional term, not to exceed three (3) years. The Local Chief of Staff's appointment is subject to annual review and confirmation by the Board.
