The New Brunswick Organ and Tissue Program (NBOTP) is a provincial program governed by the Province of New Brunswick Department of Health and operated by Horizon Health Network, in collaboration with Vitalité Health Network. The NBOTP is actively recruiting a **Regional Director**.

You will play a key role in championing the delivery of quality care and will provide overall responsibility and accountability for the retrieval and delivery of organ and tissue donations from all New Brunswick donors and the placement of these organs with Canadian transplant programs.

Why you should work here

This is a senior level position that provides an opportunity to work anywhere in NB while supporting a province-wide healthcare program. This management position comes with competitive salary, paid time off, sick benefits, employer paid contributions into our government pension plan, and a remote work policy.

What you will do

As the Regional Director, you will work in partnership with provincial stakeholders to develop and maintain a coordinated New Brunswick organ and tissue donation and retrieval system. You will create dynamic partnerships to strengthen the provincial commitment to an integrated system for donation. The regional scope of this position will require ongoing collaboration with the Regional Health Authorities, Clinical Heads, Medical Directors, Department of Health, and all other provincial stakeholders, including community stakeholders. As the Regional Director, you will also represent the NB Organ and Tissue Program on committees and activities, locally, provincially, and nationally, as required.

Within the mandate of this position, you are responsible for promoting leadership and demonstrating accountability in developing and implementing a quality management program. You will also establish and maintain the standards and regulations of Health Canada, Canadian Standards Association (CSA), Eye Bank Association of America (EBAA), and American Association of Tissue Banking (AATB), to ensure the safety of organs and tissues for transplantation.

Other duties include undertaking site visits to all New Brunswick hospitals, with medical leadership, with a focus on increased awareness of donation processes.
