

The Saint John Regional Hospital (SJRH) is the largest tertiary care hospital in New Brunswick and is the health-care referral centre for this area and to all New Brunswickers for major trauma and cardiac care. The New Brunswick Trauma Program and New Brunswick Heart Centre are located within the hospital. It is also the centre of Dalhousie Medicine New Brunswick's distributed medical education program. The Saint John area covers 200 km² and a catchment population of 170,000. The hospital has an operating budget of approximately \$360 million, with more than 5,500 employees, 410 physicians and over 1,800 volunteers.
